Pennsylvania District 15 in conjunction with the Southern Tioga Little League and Mansfield University is hosting the Pennsylvania Big League Softball State Tournament. All games will be played at Lutes Field, which is located on the campus of the University. We have arranged thru the University for special pricing for housing and meals on campus and attached will be the appropriate information. This will be available to all team members and also the parents and family members of the teams involved.

We will be running a double elimination tournament and will not be naming a State Champion as we have confirmed that we will be sending two (2) teams to Waldorf, Maryland for the Regional Tournament. The drawings for pairings will be held the morning of the 15th at noon in the Decker Gymnasium Conference Room at which time we will also have a brief managers meeting and a representative of each team must be in attendance. All affidavits and necessary paperwork will be checked at that time.

The following is the schedule of game time:

(The game times might be adjusted based on the number of teams participating)

Friday, July 15<sup>th</sup> check in for each team at noon

Games will be played at 1 – 3 – 5

Saturday, July 16<sup>th</sup>

Games will be played at noon – 2 – 4

Sunday, July 17<sup>th</sup>

Winners Bracket Final at 1pm with the winner getting the bid to Regionals

Consolation Bracket at 4pm with the winner getting the other bid to  
Regionals

The tournament committee reserves the right to adjust times as needed to keep the tournament moving. We will do everything in our power to complete the tournament in the time allowed. All decisions of the tournament committee will be final. We will follow and abide by all Little League rules and regulations with no exceptions. The tournament committee asks that you dress appropriately, that is no short shorts, no tank tops, just presentable clothing.

## **2011 BIG LEAGUE SOFTBALL STATE TOURNAMENT**

### **RULES AND PROCEDURES HIGHLIGHTS**

1. The Tournament Rules and Regulations as published by Little League Baseball shall be binding and strictly enforced.
2. All umpires are assigned by District 15 Umpire-in Chief Chuck Stimson.
3. Each manager must submit their eligibility affidavit, medical releases and all tournament eligibility information to the Tournament Director for approval.
4. The team manager is responsible for his team and all equipment (equipment will be checked by the Umpire-in-Chief and crew prior to each game). Players must be in uniform with the Little League patch. Managers and coaches shall dress neatly (no denim shorts or tank tops).
5. Only managers, coaches and players listed on the official tournament eligibility affidavit are permitted in the dugout or on the playing field. If a manager or coach cannot attend a game, the Tournament Director reserves the right to approve a one game replacement where appropriate.
6. No jewelry will be allowed on the playing field regardless of material. This includes earrings, necklaces, rings, watches and string bracelets. **MEDICAL ALERT ITEMS ARE PERMITTED.**
7. **NO TOBACCO OF ANY KIND** is permitted during games.
8. All game balls are supplied by District 15.
9. Dugout assignments: The team at the top of the official bracket will occupy the first base dugout. The team on the bottom of the official bracket will occupy the third base dugout.
10. The home team will be determined by the toss of a coin. The team occupying the top of the official bracket will call the flip and have their choice of home or visitor.

Mansfield University has graciously agreed to permit us to use University Housing for the Tournament. The Residence Hall cost will be \$26 per person per night with double occupancy rooms. This housing is also made available to parents and family members of the teams involved. The manager is responsible for providing adequate supervision to insure that all University rules are followed for his/her team during their stay on campus. This package is made available, as motel housing is very limited due to the activity in the area caused by the Marcellus Shale gas drilling that has hit our area. Persons staying in the Residence Hall should bring bed linens or sleeping bags, pillows, towels and a fan, as the hall is not air-conditioned. An estimate of how many people in your group is needed as soon as possible prior to the tournament.

Meal costs for the use of the cafeteria are: Breakfast \$4.00, Lunch \$6.00 and Dinner \$7.00. The cafeteria is available to all who are using University Housing. We will also request, as early as possible, an estimate of those who will be using the cafeteria services.
