



PRESIDENTS GUIDELINES FOR DISTRICT TOURNAMENT PLAY

1. You are responsible for all Little League Rules and District Guidelines.
2. The Host League only is responsible for the Game Director so . . . appoint qualified **Adults** as Game Directors
3. Remind your Managers and Coaches to act like ladies and gentlemen
4. Remember you are responsible for the fans at your complexes
 - a. Unruly conduct will not be tolerated
 - b. Abuse of umpires and/or players will not be tolerated
5. Starting times for all games:

6. In case of rain, we will play the next day. No game times or dates are to be changed without the prior approval of Bill Serfass, Jr. These decisions are final and there will be no exceptions.
7. It is mandatory that all your ball clubs carry their affidavits, medical release forms, maps, copies of birth certificates and proofs of residency with them at all times.
8. Remind your managers of the jewelry policy. No jewelry is allowed which includes string bracelets, only medic alert bracelets & necklaces are allowed. To do this ahead of time will save time and the umpires patience at game time.
9. Patches are mandatory on all uniforms.
10. Each team is required to bring 2 new baseballs to all games. The host team will furnish all softballs. If played at a neutral site, both teams bring 4 softballs and the team winning the toss will furnish. Only baseballs and softballs from the approved Little League Tournament List are to be used.
11. Remember to send 2 qualified **adult** umpires to each game except for the championship games where you will be required to bring just one.
12. If you win the toss for umpires and do not have a qualified umpire with you, you should not take home plate. **Do not use parents of team members for umpires. Do not bring an umpire from out of the stands.**
13. **The District will supply the Director for District Championships, and all Sectional Games**
